SUMMARY OF ESSENTIAL DUTIES:

- Inspect project sites and evaluate contractor work to detect design malfunctions and ensure conformance to design specifications and applicable code; ensure proper signage and barricading and construction are by plans.
- Enforce City ordinances, policies, procedures, and guidelines associated with on-site and off-site improvements.
- Report maintenance problems occurring at project site to supervisor and negotiate changes, as directed, to resolve system conflicts.
- Analyze proposed site factors and design maps, graphs, tracings and diagrams to illustrate findings.
- Read and review project construction documents and structural specifications to determine dimensions of structure or system and material requirements.
- Confer with supervisor to determine project details, such as plan preparation, acceptance testing and evaluation of field conditions.
- Prepare specifications and design plans for Public Works projects as directed.
- Prepare reports and document project activities and data; scan field division files, plans and records.
- Collect geographic information systems (GIS) data.
- Support the City's policies, goals and objectives and work with management and other staff to ethically achieve such goals and objectives; ensure compliance with safety procedures.
- Perform other duties as required or assigned.
- Assist with preparing engineering project estimates of probable costs using cost data or similar projects to identify capital needs.
- Responsible for assisting with Public Works Capital Projects ranging from roadway expansion, traffic signals, guardrails, and development review.
- Responsible for enhancing the safety and well-being of the community by performing
 professional engineering activities in support of Civil Engineering and Transportation
 projects, including but not limited to streets, bridges, traffic signals, and
